You will use ONE of the adjectives, phrases, and feelings you wrote from each question in the “What Marchers Sensed” activity to write a descriptive postcard to a family member. You will be one of the marchers in the photograph and you will share your thoughts and experiences from the march. Be sure to use ONE part from each of the categories. *Underline the phrases you use in your descriptive essay.* This should be a descriptive piece of writing! As you reread it when you are finished, you should have an all around physical feeling of what it was like to be on the march from Selma to Montgomery.
