

## Secondary Source Analysis Worksheet

Source citation (including at a minimum: author, title, date, and place of publication)	
About the author: What do you know about the author?	
Reliability: Does the source seem reliable? Why or why not?	
Reading notes: As you read, take notes about information that is pertinent to your project, that leaves you with questions, or to which you want to return later. Record page numbers for key points and quotes. (You may need additional space.)	
Source argument: What is the main argument or claim made by the source? How does the author make this argument? What kinds of evidence do they use?	
Reflection: Do you find the source's argument convincing? What questions do you have after reading? How does this compare to other sources you have read?
